



BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

INTRODUCTION

These are the Terms and Conditions under which you purchase a ticket to visit Beleura the House & Garden. You are bound by these Terms and Conditions, so it is important that you read them carefully. They are designed to ensure our services are provided with due care and skill. These Terms and Conditions do not alter any protection given to you by Australian consumer laws. All prices on our website are correct at the time of publication and are quoted in Australian dollars (AUD) and may be subject to change.

YOUR AGREEMENT WITH US

When you make your payment for your visit, you accept our Terms and Conditions on behalf of all visitors in your booking. Once we have received a payment, an agreement on these Terms and Conditions becomes effective between all visitors in your booking and Beleura the House & Garden.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Visitors enter these premises at their own risk. Where permitted by consumer laws and other laws, Beleura the House & Garden will not accept any responsibility for:

- a) Any loss or damage to any property brought onto the premises; or
- b) Any injury to patrons or associates of patrons whilst on the property;
- c) And to the greatest extent that you can legally do so, you release Beleura from all such liability.

In addition, our liability will be reduced in proportion to any negligence or fault on your part. By purchasing a ticket and by entering the premises you accept these Terms & Conditions. Beleura the House & Garden strongly recommends visitors wear suitable shoes for their visit. Steps, as well as a narrow carpeted hall & staircase, are involved in the tour of the House. There are uneven surfaces at Beleura House & Garden.

BOOKINGS/CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

1. All prices are correct at the time of publishing. However, they are subject to change without prior notice.
2. Visitors are reminded that for technical or operational reasons, some programmes may be altered at any time. Beleura the House & Garden reserves the right to change the programme if at any time it is deemed necessary or appropriate to do so.
3. In the event that a tour or other programme is cancelled by Beleura the House & Garden, you will be notified and a full refund will be issued.

4. A refund will not be issued to persons who fail to attend on the day of their booking.
5. A refund may be applied for if a cancellation occurs and Beleura the House & Garden is notified 48 hours in advance of the day of your booking.
6. Beleura the House & Garden reserves the right, at its absolute discretion, to refuse entry or admission or to remove from Beleura the House & Garden any visitor.
7. Beleura the House & Garden is not obligated to honour any listed prices, tours or programmes other than those listed on its website.
8. All payments must be made in AUD(\$).

SECURITY

For safety & security reasons it is not possible for visitors to leave their tour group once the tour has started.

PHOTOGRAPHS

Photographs are not permitted to be taken inside the House during your tour however you are welcome to take photographs in and of the Garden.

DISABLED ACCESS

For Beleura the House & Garden to offer appropriate assistance you are required to make us aware of the special needs of you or any member of your group in advance of your arrival. Wheelchair and Walker access is limited both inside the House and in the Garden.

RIGHTS OF THE DIRECTOR

If a visitor seriously affects their own safety, wellbeing or enjoyment, or that of any other visitor, the Director has the right to ask the visitor to leave the premises. In such cases, we are not responsible for any expenses incurred including your return home. In addition, you will not be entitled to any refunds. While the Director will always act reasonably in these circumstances, you accept that the safety, wellbeing and enjoyment of everyone visiting, comes first.

CODE RED DAYS

Should a Code Red Day affect the Mornington Peninsula area and more specifically the area surrounding Beleura and Mornington itself, your tour may be cancelled. The following quote is provided by the CFA web site, it defines what a Code Red day is:
